The member has the following tasks:

- Attending the Executive Board meetings and providing input for the agenda,

- Attending the General Assembly (GA) to ensure the alignment with the members of the EFPC,

The competences of the member include the following aspects:

And the following conditions are imperative:

- Time availability / flexibility,
- Preferably a Primary Care professional with a non-Medical background and with a link to research (e.g. an academic nurse, midwife or allied health professional),
- Preferably with a geographical background in the European regions which are now underrepresented which are Northern and Eastern Europe,
- Large network, including links with international institutions and
- Good English understanding, reading and writing and one other language (or at least a workable second language).

The ExBo exists of 6 members. Among themselves, Executive Board members appoint a chairperson, each time for a period of 3 years with a prolongation of 2 times 3 years maximum.
